CAPE ELIZABETH - Thomas Charles Jones, 73, of Cape Elizabeth, Maine, died unexpectedly at his home on Thursday, January 19, 2017.

Born in Providence, Rhode Island on August 21, 1943, he was the son of Richard A. Jones Sr., and Virginia M. Jones. He was the brother of the late Richard A. Jones Jr. and Priscilla E. Kibbe. His mother was from Calais, Maine and they spent many summers traveling from Rhode Island to the family retreat in Meddybemps, Maine.

Thomas married his high school sweetheart, Carolyn Todd Jones, on June 12, 1965. Together they raised four boys, Todd David Jones, Christopher Thomas Jones, Eric Richard Jones, and Brian Mathew Jones. They lived in Manchester, Connecticut and Andover, Massachusetts where they made lifelong friends.

Thomas and Carolyn moved to Cape Elizabeth, Maine in 2010, where they were immediately welcomed by the Shore Acres community. He enjoyed swimming at the community pool and exploring the hiking trails, parks, beaches and coastlines of the area. He loved sailing, kayaking, going to the beach, and attending many of the arts and cultural events in the greater Portland area.

He was a devoted husband and role model to his children and grandchildren. His quiet demeanor and wonderful sense of humor provided great comfort and strength to those around him. He placed his family first and cherished the time he spent with all of them throughout his life.

Thomas attended the University of Rhode Island, graduating in 1965 with a degree in financial accounting. He went on to hold various positions in the field of real estate development and affordable housing, including Arthur Anderson, The Simon Konover Company, Southern Middlesex Opportunity Council, and the Archdioceses of Boston's Planning Office of Urban Affairs.

He is survived by his loving wife, Carolyn, his four sons, Todd, Chris, Eric and Brian, their spouses, Natalie, Merritt, Erika, and Nikki, and nine grandchildren, Megan, Shannon, Lucas, Jack, Liam, Madeline, Grace, Makenzie, and Addison. He is also survived by Megan and Shannon's mother, Kim Jones, and by many nieces and nephews who meant so much to him.
