## Tour the new Harbor Place boardwalk on Friday

HAVERHILL – Merrimack Street Ventures LLC, a partnership of the Greater Haverhill Foundation and the Planning Office for Urban Affairs will host a public tour of the new Harbor Place boardwalk on Friday, Sept. 23, at 1 p.m. beginning at the Basiliere Bridge.

The tour will be led by State Rep. Brian Dempsey, Mayor James Fiorentini and representatives from Merrimack Street Ventures.

This will be the only time the public will have full access to the boardwalk before the official opening of Harbor Place at the end of the year. The boardwalk runs along Merrimack Street from the bridge to Haverhill Bank.

Haverhill is on the move as a Gateway City taking full advantage of its distinctive assets, including educational and cultural institutions, and, historic buildings for economic growth. Harbor Place is one of the largest projects launched in the Merrimack Valley in decades and is a transformative investment for Haverhill.

### Trails & Sails events this weekend
